



The 2015 Declaration of British Values

Our Vision

To enable every voter across the United Kingdom to vote for a Christian candidate who upholds the Word of God in the General Election on 7th May 2015.

We have had requests from Christians across the UK asking if we are standing a candidate in their constituency in the General Election on 7th May 2015. We are currently unable to stand in every constituency, However, our **2015 Declaration of British Values Campaign** will support Christian candidates everywhere regardless of party allegiance.

We are calling all candidates to:

- Pledge to respect, uphold and protect the right of Christians to hold and express their beliefs and to act according to Christian conscience,
- Protect human life,
- Protect traditional marriage
- Protect British law.

All of which are foundational for creating and maintaining strong families, caring communities and a just society. Our Christian faith compels us to speak and act in defence of all these

This campaign is a joint effort between the Christian Party, Christian organisations and Christian voters to identify the candidates in each Parliamentary constituency. It is based on the Westminster Declaration, 2010, now with over 70,000 supporters. We believe that our British Values are rooted in our Christian heritage and are carrying on the good work that they started. Details about Parliamentary candidates can be entered by the party, voters or the candidates themselves. Candidates will then be invited to sign our 2015 British Values Declaration. The public will be able to access the full list of candidates standing in their constituency to see who has signed and who needs to be encouraged to sign! You will then be in a good position to judge who will get your vote on **May 7th**. At the end of this, if you find that there is no-one willing to sign the declaration, maybe it's time that someone from your church stood to represent your constituency.

STAND

In the Christian Party, we have the freedom to declare God's truths wherever we can, and to apply Christian solutions to our social needs through the political process. Only by being in public life will people see and witness the Christian concern of Christian councillors, politicians and others holding a wide range of public offices.

There is a growing opportunity to make a witness and a Christian difference in this Election. If you are excited about the possibility of being involved in local issues, maybe you are being called to **be a local councillor**. There are vacancies across the country in parish and community councils, town and county councils, and at constituency level. **Sign up as a member today**, and if you are willing to stand, we will contact you.

HELP

If you are unable to stand yourself, perhaps you can help us to find fellow Christians to stand and represent you. Perhaps **you can canvass, pray, donate** or **organise a hustings event** (67% are organised by



churches) to help a fellow Christian proclaim the Lordship of Jesus Christ where they live. It costs £500 to stand a candidate in a constituency.

We respect and support Christians in other parties and we thank God that they uphold and fight for the same values as we do. Indeed we consider their job to be harder than ours with secular humanism pervading all the main parties without exception. Their work is cut out to remain true to their beliefs, and to be strong enough to stand against the whip in their party on many moral issues.
